CHANGES TO LEVEL 3 REGULATIONS

ALERT LEVEL 3

THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES ARE NOW ALLOWED AT LEVEL 3, with strict adherence to health protocols and social distancing measures:



RESTAURANTS FOR SIT-DOWN MEALS, WITH LIMITED CAPACITY

- A **register** must be kept of all **employees, delivery agents** and **patrons** to assist with contact tracing if necessary
- Employees and delivery agents **must be screened** upon arrival, and **provided with masks and hand sanitiser**
- Employees and delivery drivers should **sanitise before and after all card payments**
- Restaurants are **required to conduct a screening questionnaire** on guests, and may **refuse admission** if they deem a guest is a safety risk
- **Masks must be worn at all times** except where eating and drinking
- Customers should be **seated 1.5 metres apart**
- Restaurants should consider a **reservation system** where possible to manage demand and ensure capacity limits
- **No self-service buffets** are allowed
- **Menus must be replaced** with **non-touch options** or sanitised after each use
- **Tables must be sanitised** before and after each guest
- **Windows must be kept open** where possible



PERSONAL CARE SERVICES, INCLUDING HAIRDRESSERS

- A **register** must be kept of all **employees and clients** to assist with contact tracing if necessary
- **Equipment must be sanitised** before and after each use
- **Windows must be kept open** where possible
- **Masks must be worn at all times**
- Stylists must also wear a **face shield/visor** that must be **cleaned** after serving each client
- A distance of **1.5 metres must be maintained** between people at all times
- A **booking system** should be used for treatments where possible, and no guests should be allowed
- **No scalp, neck and shoulder massages** should be offered before hair treatments



CONFERENCES AND MEETINGS

- A maximum of **50 people allowed** in the venue
- Restricted to **work purposes only**



CASINOS, CINEMAS AND THEATRES

- A **maximum of 50 people** at any time (in the case of casinos, the number of people is restricted to 50% of the available floor space)
- **Performers and crew** limited to a **maximum of 15 people**



MUSEUMS, GALLERIES, LIBRARIES AND ARCHIVES

- A **maximum of 50 people** at any time



SPORTING EVENTS

- For **non-contact sporting matches only**, which may only include players, match officials, journalists, medical and television crew
- **Contact sports for training only**



ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS

with the exception of private homes for paid leisure accommodation

- Only for **essential work** purposes
